and base reacts, an ionic compound is produced as one of the products. We call ionic compounds "salts".

Acids, Bases and Salts

Salts . When acid and base neutralize, salts are formed. Strong acid and strong base combines to form neutral salt. $\text{NaOH} + \text{HCl} \rightarrow \text{NaCl} + \text{H}_2\text{O}$. Eq.1. Formation of Neutral Salt. Strong acid and weak base combine to form acidic salt. For Example, Hydrochloric Acid and ammonium hydroxide combine to form ammonium chloride. Other examples, sodium hydrogen carbonate, sodium hydrogen sulphate etc.

(a) HCl is acid and NaOH is base whose combination forms the common salt. Its formula is NaCl (Sodium chloride). It is obtained from sea water. (b) Rock salt is the common name for the mineral "halite". Its chemical formula is NaCl. It may be white or light blue or yellow depending upon impurities present in it.

Bases - Bases are compounds which give hydroxide ion in water solution. For example, Sodium hydroxide (NaOH), Potassium hydroxide (KOH), Calcium hydroxide (Ca (OH) 2). Salts - Salts are compounds obtained by replacement of H from acid by a metal. For example, Sodium chloride (NaCl), Copper sulphate (CuSO 4), Potassium nitrate (KNO 3).
