Screening Tools - DBP

Child and adolescent psychiatry (or pediatric psychiatry) is a branch of psychiatry that focuses on the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of mental disorders in children, adolescents, and their families. It investigates the biopsychosocial factors that influence the development and course of these psychiatric disorders and treatment responses to various interventions.

"Evidence-Based Child and Adolescent Psychosocial Interventions" uses a broad level of analysis for defining treatments, such that interventions sharing a majority of components with similar clinical strategies and theoretical underpinnings are considered to belong to a single treatment approach.

Assessment of Young Children. The assessment of young children (age 0-5) should incorporate a developmental, relational, and biological perspective on the presenting symptoms and include data collected on interview, observation of dyadic or triadic interactions, as well scores on validated screening tools.
