After independence, English common law still exerted influence over American common law – for example, *Byrne v Boadle* (1863), which first applied the *res ipsa loquitur* doctrine.

Jurisdictions that have kept to the common law may incorporate modern legal developments from England, and English decisions are usually persuasive in such jurisdictions.
