Although nonprofits do need revenue to operate, earning profits is not their primary function. Many nonprofits receive tax-exempt status. If you qualify for tax-exempt status, you are not required to pay federal business income taxes. However, you might still need to pay state and local income taxes.

Your non-profit organisation may need to pay tax if it uses some of its income on things not related to the charity (this is known as 'non-charitable expenditure') or if some of the income received doesn't qualify for tax relief. In this case, you will need to fill out a tax return. If you don't have any tax to pay, you only have to file a tax return if HM Revenue asks you to.
