(A) To optimize drug therapy, a pharmacist shall communicate to the patient or the patient's agent, information about the prescription drug or device which in the exercise of the pharmacist's professional judgment the pharmacist deems significant, such as the following:

Pharmacist-Conducted Patient Education and Counseling

Pharmacists provided their perspectives on admission and discharge medication reconciliation, in-hospital patient counseling, provision of simple medication adherence aids (eg, pill box, illustrated daily medication schedule), and telephone follow-up.

Counseling requirements In 19 states, the pharmacist is required to provide oral counseling to patients in certain situations.²³ For example, the most common provision requires a pharmacist to counsel patients orally prior to dispensing a new prescription. In 29 states, the pharmacist is only required to “offer to counsel” patients.²⁴

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
