## **Confounding Variables | Definition, Examples and Controls**

Confounding is a distortion (inaccuracy) in the estimated measure of association that occurs when the primary exposure of interest is mixed up with some other factor that is associated with the outcome. In the diagram below, the primary goal is to ascertain the strength of association between physical inactivity and heart disease.

## **What is Confounding?**

A confounding variable is independently associated with both the risk factor (exposure) and the disease (outcome). Because of the dual association, the confounding variable creates a false association between the risk factor and disease or can exaggerate or hide a true association.

Matching is often used in case-control studies, and it has much the same effect as restriction in controlling confounding. For example, say we are looking at a particular birth defect (outcome) and maternal smoking (exposure), and we suspect that maternal age is a possible confounder.
