The Purpose of Building a Portfolio Assessment

Portfolio assessment is a term with many meanings, and it is a process that can serve a variety of purposes. A portfolio is a collection of student work that can exhibit a student's efforts, progress, and achievements in various areas of the curriculum. A portfolio assessment can be an examination of student-selected samples of work experiences and documents related to outcomes being assessed, and it can address and support progress toward achieving academic goals, including student efficacy.

PORTFOLIO ASSESSMENT IS MOST USEFUL FOR: *Evaluating programs that have flexible or individualized goals or outcomes. For example, within a program with the general purpose of enhancing children's social skills, some individual children may need to become less aggressive while other shy children may need to become more assertive.

The Use of Portfolio to Assess Student's Performance

Are Portfolios Authentic Assessments? Some suggest that portfolios are not really assessments at all because they are just collections of previously completed assessments. But, if we consider assessing as gathering of information about someone or something for a purpose, then a portfolio is a type of assessment. Sometimes the portfolio is also evaluated or graded, but that is not necessary to be considered an assessment.

Portfolios (Authentic Assessment Toolbox)

The primary function of an assessment portfolio is to document what a student has learned. The content of the curriculum, then, will determine what students select for their portfolios. Their reflective comments will focus on the extent to which they believe the portfolio entries demonstrate their mastery of the curriculum objectives.

Why use Portfolios?

Portfolio assessment is an assessment form that learners do together with their teachers, and is an alternative to the classic classroom test. The portfolio contains samples of the learner's work and shows growth over time.

Portfolio assessment - itslearning

Because the contents of portfolios are scored using specific criteria, the use of assessment portfolios is considered criterion-referenced assessment. Portfolios can provide a continuous picture of student progress, rather than a 3 snapshot of student achievement that single-occasion tests provide.

A portfolio is a folder of personal data on an individual. The folder is created by the student, provides an opportunity for students to select and examine work in progress, reflect upon projects and is organized to demonstrate students' strengths and progress toward developmental or instructional goals.

Portfolios can be used as a comprehensive form of student assessment in a course in which specific course work or products are collected and compiled for review by the professor or outside reviewers. In some programs, a formal "portfolio review" is necessary for student advancement in that program of study.
